



## Pre-Inspection Checklist

In order to provide the most complete inspection possible, it is crucial that the following requirements are met:

- Adequate space:** -To fully extend all slideouts and awnings.  
-To safely move a ladder around all sides of the RV.  
-To access the undercarriage.  
-To stand on the roof.
- Refrigerator:** -Must be powered on **at least 12 hours prior to the inspection.**
- Propane:** -Tanks at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  full.
- Generator:** -Fuel and oil all must be at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  full.
- Hookups:** -Shore power supply - 50A or 30A.  
-City water connection - if unavailable, the freshwater tank.  
-Freshwater tank at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  full.  
-Wastewater / Sewer hookups - preferred but not required.
- Personal Items:** -Personal contents should be removed. Inspector will not move any personal items in order to gain access to an inspection point.
- Keys:** -ALL keys must be made available for the inspector.

\*\*\*If the owner has the original build sheet or manuals, these are very helpful to the inspection.
