

Pre-Inspection Checklist

In order to provide the most complete inspection possible, it is crucial that the following requirements are met:

Adequate space: -To fully extend all slideouts and awnings.

-To safely move a ladder around all sides of the RV.

-To access the undercarriage.

-To stand on the roof.

Refrigerator: -Must be powered on at least 12 hours prior to the inspection.

Propane: -Tanks at least ½ full.

Generator: -Fuel and oil all must be at least ½ full.

Hookups: -Shore power supply - 50A or 30A.

-City water connection - if unavailable, the freshwater tank.

-Freshwater tank at least ½ full.

-Wastewater / Sewer hookups - preferred but not required.

Personal Items: -Personal contents should be removed. Inspector will not move any personal

items in order to gain access to an inspection point.

Keys: -ALL keys must be made available for the inspector.

***If the owner has the original build sheet or manuals, these are very helpful to the inspection.
